SUMMARY FOR THE MONTH

1. The LASI closed at 6,170.77 recording a 0.81% decline from last month's close and a 15.83% year to date increase.
2. The LUSE market capitalisation posted an increase of 0.09% from last month.
3. The Depository Cap as of 31st October 2014 was recorded at 14,935.67
4. On average, the Daily market volumes and Turnover were recorded at 220,910 and K660,723 respectively
5. The market recorded a total of 413 trades in Equity and 4 in Government Bonds.
6. The Market recorded a total of US\$686,853 net inflows and US\$726,141 outflows representing a total of 62.43% of foreign participation.

LuSE GUIDANCE NOTE
On the 14th of 2014 the LuSE issued a guidance note to the market.
The Purpose of this Guidance Note was to provide direction to the market players and in particular the listed companies and the sponsoring brokers as to the intent and general operation of the Listings and Exchange Rules that deal with announcements, advertisements and general communication to the public or shareholders on the procedures or steps required to be taken before dissemination of information.

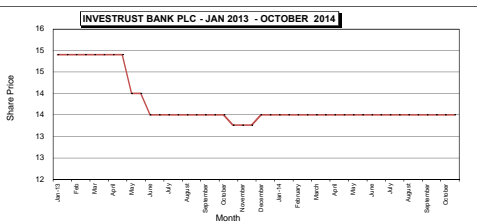
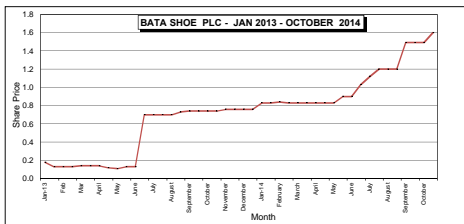
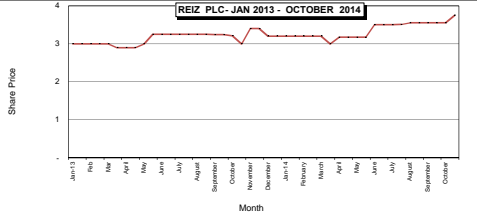
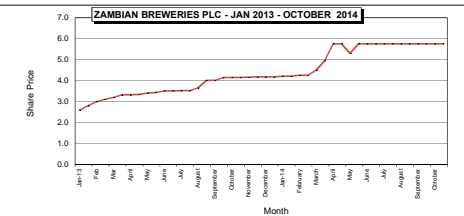
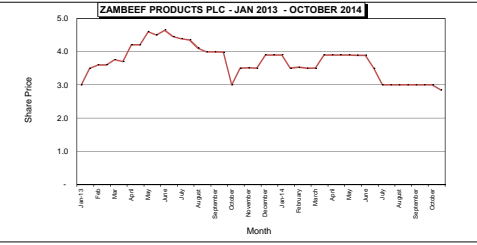
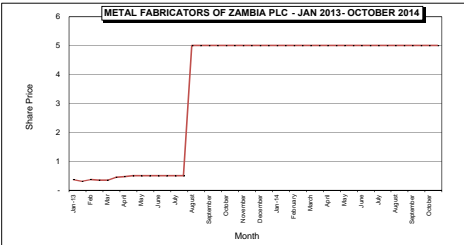
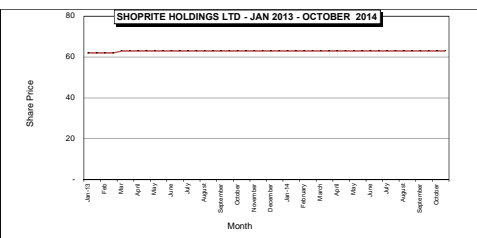
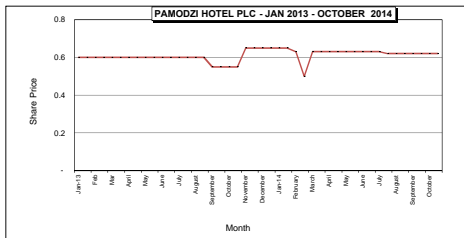
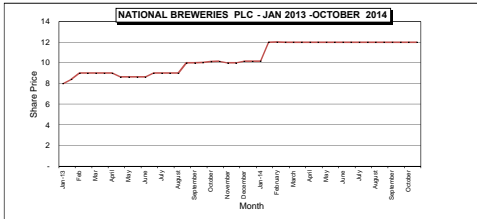
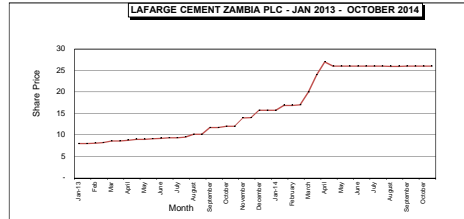
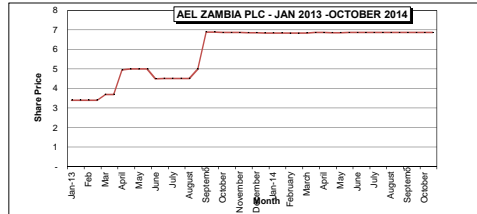
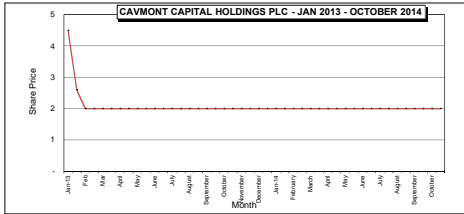
Shareholders were referred to the announcements released on SENS on 29 September 2014 regarding the posting of the Company's Integrated Annual Report and the notices of annual general meeting for ordinary shareholders and Special General Meetings of SHP1, SHP2, SHP3 and SHP4 shareholders (collectively, the "General Meetings"), whereby the Board of Directors of Shoprite Holdings had resolved, inter alia, to propose amendments to the Company's Memorandum of Incorporation ("MOI") in order to convert the Preference Shares currently in issue and listed on the JSE Limited's Main Board, being SHP1, SHP2, SHP3 and SHP4 ("Preference Shares"), into cumulative redeemable preference shares, to be redeemed at a price of R2.00 (two Rand) per Preference Share on 17 November 2014 (the "Redemptions").

Shareholders of the Company were advised that the resolutions proposed at the SHP1 General Meeting of the Company held today, including the resolutions relating to the redemption of the SHP1 preference shares, were approved by the requisite majority of shareholders present or represented by proxy. The SHP2, SHP3 and SHP4 General Meetings were cancelled as the requisite majority of shareholders did not vote or submit proxies to vote in terms of the resolutions relating to the redemptions of the SHP2, SHP3 and SHP4 preference shares. The special resolutions approved by SHP1 shareholders will be filed with the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission ("CIPC") on 27th October, 2014.

LuSE DONATES SOCCER KITS TO ZAMBIAN ASSOCIATION OF MUSICIANS

As a way of celebrating Zambia's Golden Jubilee, LuSE donated 2 full set soccer kits to Zambia Association of Musicians (ZAM). This donation was done during the capital market exhibition a 4 day event which was held at the arcades shopping mall from the 20th to the 23rd October 2014.
